CITY COUNCIL MEETING RECAP

May 4, 2021

The following is a recap from the City Council meeting on Tuesday, May 4, 2021. The Yorba Linda City Council:

- Received a presentation from Tom Lindsey, Yorba Linda Water District Director, regarding the District's proposed rate schedule increase.
- Recognized the Spring 2021 Young Civic Leaders Academy students.
- Awarded a professional services agreement to Sally Swanson Architects, Inc. in the amount of \$275,465 for preparation of the City's Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Self Evaluation and Transition Plan.
- Authorized the proposed improvements to encroach within the City's drainage easement located at 5400 Kodiak Mountain, at the south side of the property, determined such encroachments will not adversely impact the City's easement, City's facility, or general public safety, and required the owner to execute a Declaration of Restrictive Covenants Agreement pursuant to City Council Policy E-5.
- Awarded a professional service agreement to TJKM Transportation Consultants (TJKM) in the amount of \$62,994.95 for the Local Roadway Safety Plan (LRSP).
- Entered into a new agreement with the Placentia Yorba Linda Unified School District (PYLUSD) for joint use of Yorba Linda Middle School.
- Awarded the contract for the T.R.A.I.L.S. (Taking Retired Adults Into Local Services) Senior Mobility Program to California Yellow Cab and authorized the Mayor to sign and City Clerk to attest said agreement.
- Approved the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Friends of the Yorba Linda Public Library (the Friends) and the City of Yorba Linda (the City).
- Upheld the Local Emergency Proclamation made by the Director of Emergency Services on March 16, 2020 and determined that the need for the Local Emergency Proclamation is continuing.
- Approved City Flag Contest entry #23 and directed City staff to bring back a resolution at the May 18, 2021 City Council Meeting to adopt the selected flag as the official Yorba Linda City flag

- Authorized the City Manager to execute the agreement with Sage Environmental Group, LLC for a goat grazing weed abatement pilot program in the amount of (\$12,990.73) at the City-owned parcels located north of Bastanchury Road, between Casa Loma Avenue and Eureka Avenue (APN#'S: 323-151-03, 323-161-06 AND 08) also referred to as the West Bastanchury site.
- Received an update on the Sixth Cycle Housing Element and housing legislation.
- Voted to support Senate Bill 623 (Newman).
- Voted to oppose Assembly Bill 339 (Lee).

The meeting adjourned at 9:19 p.m. to the next City Council meeting on May 18, 2021 at 6:30 p.m.
