RESOLUTION NO. 94-2894

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YORBA LINDA INITIATING PROCEEDINGS, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE LANDSCAPING AND LIGHTING ACT OF 1972, TO CONSOLIDATE YORBA LINDA LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS NOS. 1, 2, 3, 5, AND 7 INTO THE CITY-WIDE YORBA LINDA STREET LIGHTING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 2, AND RENAMING THE CONSOLIDATED DISTRICT THE "YORBA LINDA LIGHTING AND LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT"

WHEREAS, there currently exists in the City of Yorba Linda five landscape assessment districts known as Landscape Maintenance Assessment Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7; and

WHEREAS, there currently exists in the City of Yorba Linda a City-wide assessment district known as the Street Lighting Assessment District No. 2; and

WHEREAS, Landscape Maintenance Assessment Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7, and Street Lighting Assessment District No. 2 are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Assessment Districts"; and

WHEREAS, in order to continue to provide for the expenses and servicing of facilities within the boundaries of the Assessment Districts and to reduce the administrative cost incurred in administering the Assessment Districts, it is necessary to consolidate the Assessment Districts into a single City-wide lighting and landscaping maintenance assessment district pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish the consolidation into a City-wide maintenance district, Landscape Maintenance Assessment Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7 are proposed to be consolidated into the City-wide Street Lighting Assessment District No. 2; and

WHEREAS, said consolidated district shall be designated the "Yorba Linda Lighting and Landscaping Maintenance District;"

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Yorba Linda resolves as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 22605 et seq., the City Council hereby initiates proceedings for the consolidation of Landscape Maintenance Assessment Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3, 5, and 7 into the City-wide Street Lighting Assessment District No. 2 and the proposed consolidated district shall be designated the "Yorba Linda Lighting and Landscaping Maintenance District."

Section 2. The existing improvements in the Assessment Districts, and as proposed for the consolidated district, are the maintenance of landscaping of parks, greenbelts, multi-purpose trails, median islands, and slopes adjacent to public right-of-ways, and service, maintenance, and operation of public lighting facilities.

Section 3. The consolidated Yorba Linda Lighting and Landscaping Maintenance District would encompass all of the territory of the Assessment Districts and be coterminous with the present boundaries of the City, excepting from the assessment of said costs and expenses the area of all public streets, public avenues, public lands, public roads, public drives, public courts, public alleys, easements and rights-of-way, all public parks, green belts, and parkways, public median islands, and slopes, and all public school property used for public purposes, but including all railroad, gas or electric utility right-of-way or electric line rights-of-way. Pursuant to Streets and Highways Code Section 22611, upon consolidation the Yorba Linda Lighting and Landscaping Maintenance District shall assume all assets and liabilities of the Assessment Districts and shall be entitled to all of the property

tax revenues to which each of the separate Assessment Districts involved in the consolidation would have been entitled had such Assessments Districts not been consolidated.

Section 4. The City Engineer is hereby directed to prepare and file a report in accordance with Streets and Highways Code Section 22265 et seq.


