SUBJECT: Landscape Maintenance Assessment District (LMAD) Local Landscaping Zone L-1A Proposition 218 Actions Update

Dear Property Owner:

You are receiving this letter because you are listed as a property owner within Local Landscaping Zone **L-1A**. We wanted to first thank those of you that were able to attend the first Community Meeting on October 8, 2019 at City Hall Council Chambers. Your voices were heard; and the thoughtful discussion and feedback was much appreciated. We also wanted to provide you with an update to the initial letter you received, dated September 19, 2019. Please be aware, that there will be no action related to your **L-1A** Zone at the City Council Meeting this Tuesday, November 19, 2019 as stated in the previous correspondence.

At this time there will be a deferral of a Prop 218 Vote for Zone **L-1A**, utilizing the zone reserves to offset costs. Instead during this time we will re-evaluate the nuances of this zone and focus on the ability to do some restoration projects. We will still plan to schedule a follow-up Community Meeting in early 2020 to continue our open discussion about actions involving your zone. At the meeting we will also have staff from other City departments there to help answer questions, including the Orange County Fire Authority (OCFA). We will continue to provide updates on the budget and potential actions for a future Prop 218 Vote in preparation for Fiscal Year 2021-2022.
